We were actually looking out for work at the beginning of the year & are really very pleased to be able to do these paintings for you. I did not realize that you wished them done by a certain date & we certainly will get all we can done by June.

The weather has been frightfully hot which has been a decided handicap, but it is bound to get cooler soon & we then will be able to go out every day.

The four sheets I am sending are from Hoverspoort seven miles out of town. We had to go out twice to the cave because we spent most of the ^{time} fighting ticks & fleas & ants & consequently couldn't get much work done.

I think that if we went to Outdshoorn early next month, Friday ^{6th May} ~~the seventh~~ would be a suitable date



giving us time to get the ones at Salem &
Alicedale done first. Would it be advisable
to do the ones at Humansdorp at the same
time because we would have to sleep the
night there anyway on our way to Outshoorn?
