At last a selection from the copies of Bushman paintings made by you is to be published by Methuens in a volume similar to Rock-Paintings in South Africa, to be called More Rock-Paintings in South Africa. Unfortunately not a third of the collection can be included. I have tried to put in at least one example from each site, but have not quite succeeded. I have included two copies from Piquet-berg, made by my niece and a young friend.

Methuens have sent me out bromide photos of the paintings selected and of a few of your snaps. I have numbered the plates as they are to appear in the book, and have made a list of plates and places. As in the former volume a page of text is to appear opposite each plate. I have written the text for plates 27 & 28, that I was able to do, having visited the caves myself. Will you write the text for the other plates in the same way? I am sending by book post the bromide photos and the list.

As I have done for Piquetberg, I want a general description of the physical features of each district to precede the 1st plate from that district. Then I want the Locality..., Site... and Description... given, as I have done. You need not fill up Remarks..., unless you have something you particularly want to say. I will fill in that part. Description ... should tell of the general work in the cave or shelter. If you can borrow a copy of Rock-Paintings in South Africa 15 might be a help. Where more than one picture is from the same place, you can just put Locality... As Plate so-and-so. Please be as definite as possible about the places and owners.

Methuens have also sent out a photostat of the sketch map of Albany and asked questions about it. I am sending on the map and their letter. Please make any alterations required.

I do hope you are able and willing to do this work, for which I shall be glad to pay you £20 -. I am writing the introduction. I want both our names to be on the book. The publishers want the copy soon. With kind regards also to your mother and aunt,
